☆ TALENT / OPPORTUNITY / RECOGNITION

The GTCNI Student Teacher Awards were initiated in 2007 to celebrate the hard work, dedication and talent of teacher education students aspiring to be great teachers.

The Student Teacher Award recognises excellence in the practical application of reflective practice by initial teacher education students graduating from each of the Northern Ireland Higher Education Institutions (*HEIs*). In a competitive labour market this prestigious award is a highly respected and valued addition to a graduate teacher's CV, enabling them to stand out as 'best in class'.

☆ Who is Eligible?

Final year PGCE and BEd students studying at any of the Higher Education Institutions in Northern Ireland are eligible to apply for the STAR Award.

The award recognises students who have achieved at a consistently high level.

☆ Assessment

Each participating HEI selects two award winners based on academic and practical assessment carried out as part of their course of study and placement.

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☆ The Award

Each student is awarded a framed certificate and £400 to facilitate engagement in continuous professional development. The STAR Award continues to promote positive values, build relationships with our partner HEIs and reward our local student teachers.
